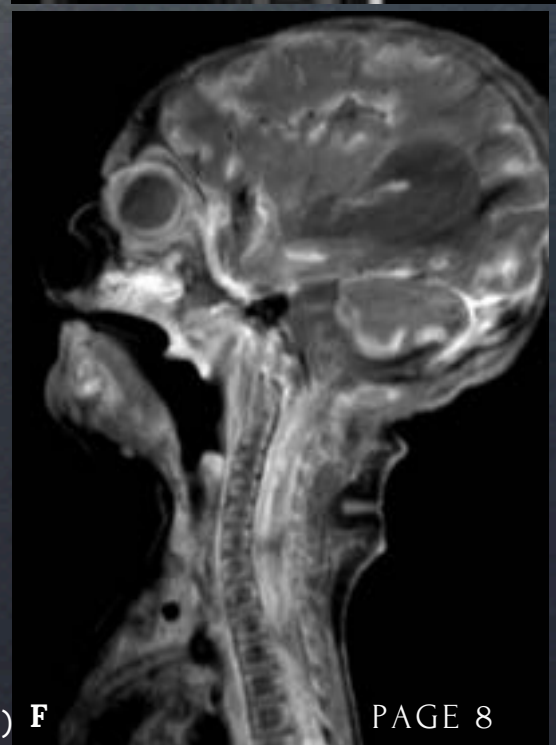
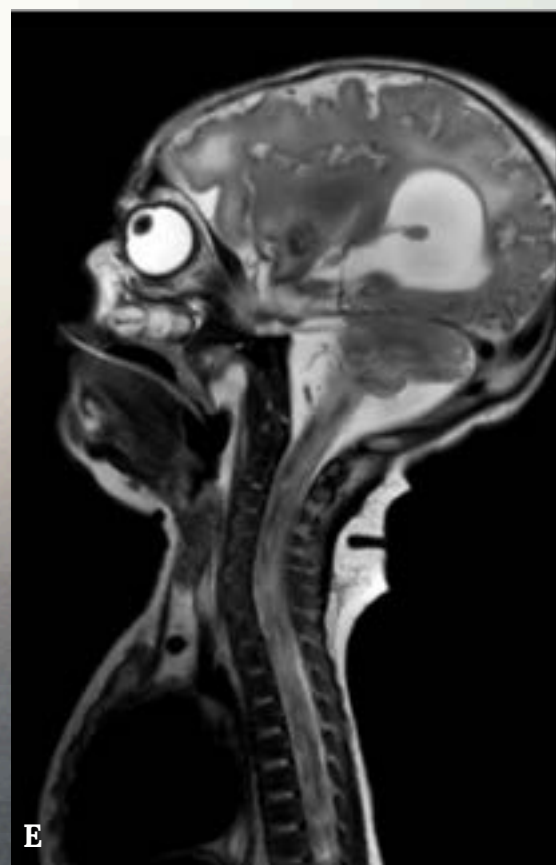
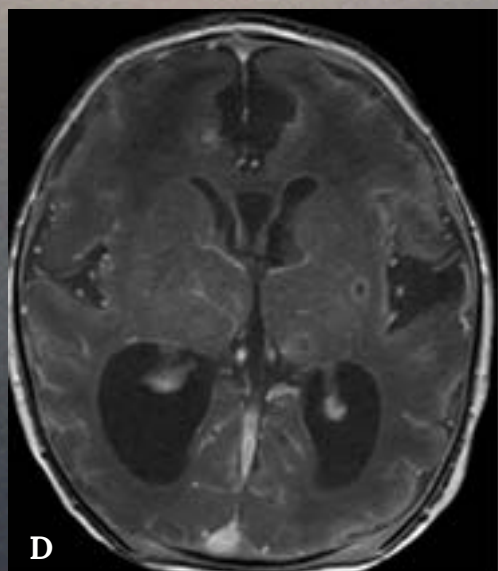
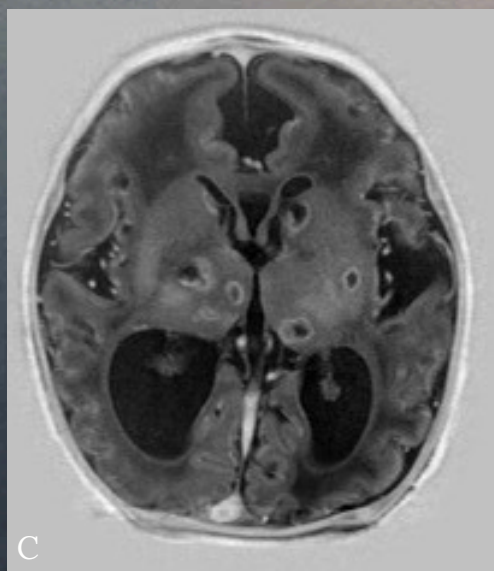
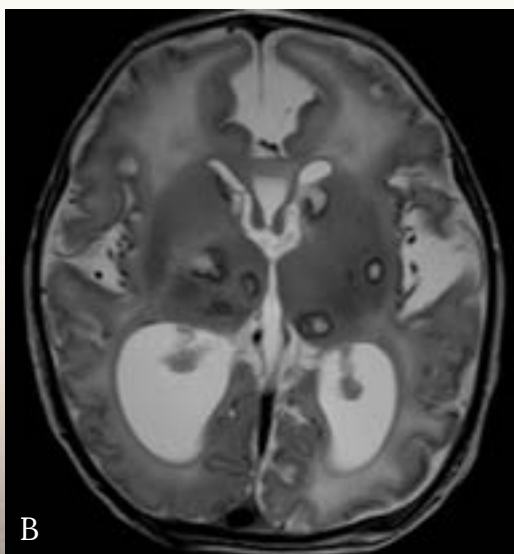
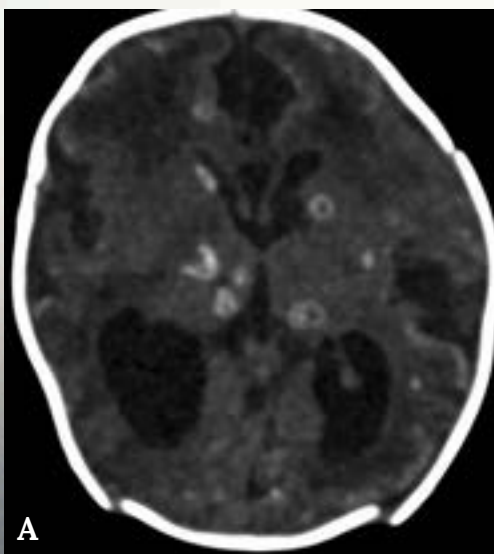
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Interesting Case: TORCH-ED

10 day old term neonate with hypotonia. No significant perinatal history.

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Interesting Case : DISCUSSION

Axial CT image (A), axial T2-weighted (B), pre-contrast T1 IR (C) and post contrast T1-weighted (C) images show multiple peripherally calcified lesions diffusely scattered in bilateral basal ganglia, thalami and also in both cerebral hemispheres. These show T2 hypointense rim and peripheral enhancement. Also seen is bilateral lateral ventriculomegaly and leptomeningeal enhancement along bilateral temporo-occipital cortical sulci. Sagittal T2 (E) and sagittal T1 post contrast (F) of the cervicodorsal spine show similar morphology lesions throughout the cord.

IMAGING DIFFERENTIALS:

- Congenital cytomegalovirus - predominantly periventricular calcifications, polymicrogyria, temporal lobe cysts, and white matter injury, microcephaly, hearing loss
- Congenital toxoplasmosis-multiple scattered or nodular intracranial calcifications involving the basal ganglia, corticomedullary junction, and periventricular regions
- Congenital Zika syndrome- severe microcephaly, cortical malformations, ventriculomegaly, and coarse subcortical calcifications.
- Aicardi Goutiere syndrome - also known as pseudoTORCH and can closely mimic imaging findings of congenital TORCH spectrum.
- Aicardi syndrome- Characteristic lacunar retinopathy like Toxoplasmosis or LCMV. But usually has dysgenesis of corpus callosum, vertebral anomalies, lack of calcifications.

FINAL DIAGNOSIS (On CSF evaluation):

Congenital Toxoplasmosis

- Congenital toxoplasmosis typically demonstrates multiple scattered or nodular intracranial calcifications involving the basal ganglia, corticomedullary junction, and periventricular regions, often accompanied by hydrocephalus on CT. MRI findings include cerebral volume loss, white matter signal abnormalities, cortical malformations, ventriculitis, and enhancing parenchymal nodules. Diffusion-weighted imaging may demonstrate areas of active inflammation, while post-contrast sequences can reveal leptomeningeal or ependymal enhancement.
- The combination of diffuse intracranial calcifications, hydrocephalus, and chorioretinitis strongly favors congenital toxoplasmosis in the appropriate clinical setting.

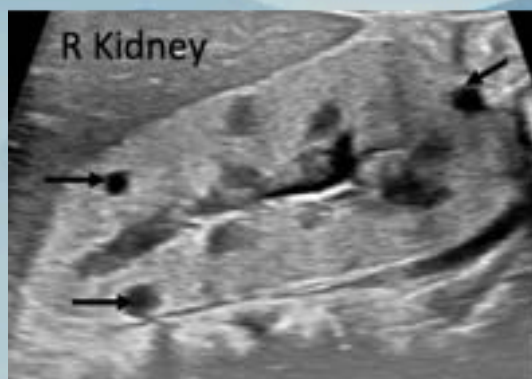
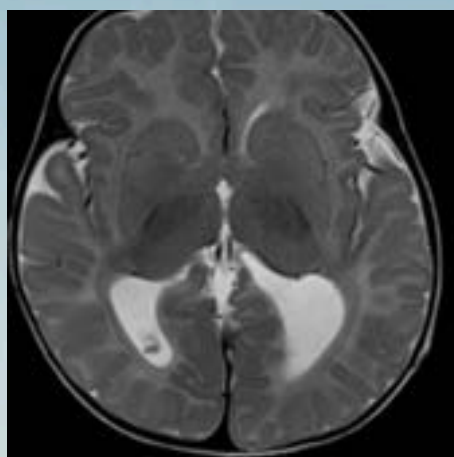
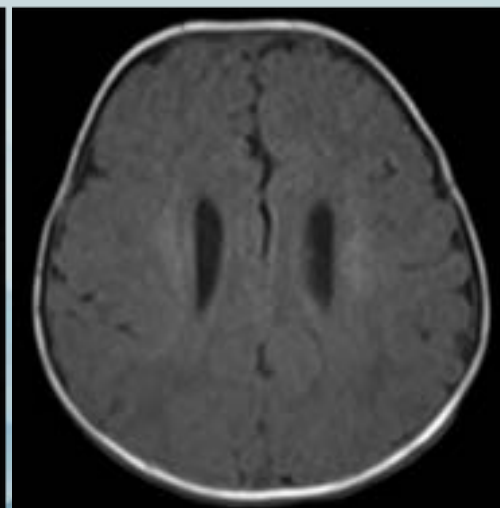
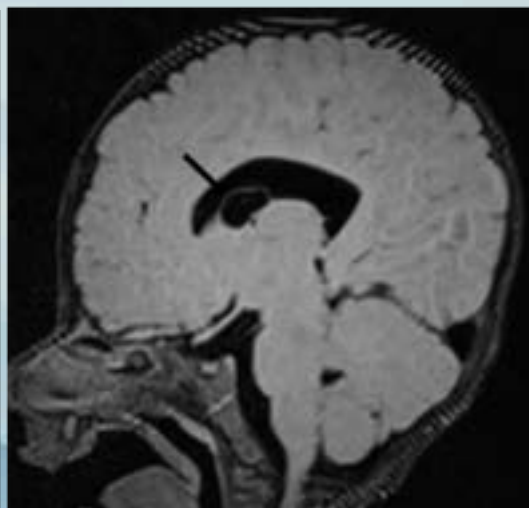
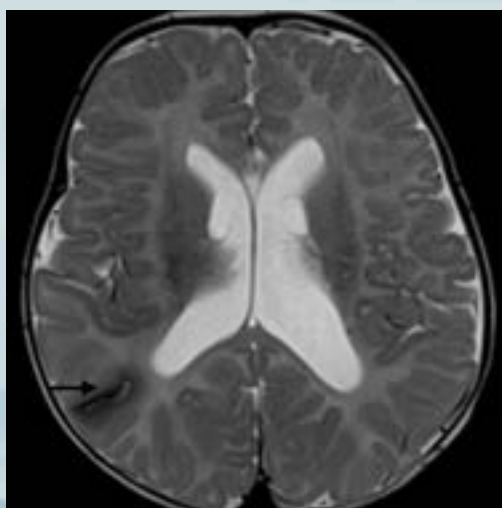
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QUIZ TIME

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ISPR Midterm CME Udaipur, March 2026

The ISPR National Midterm CME 2026 was successfully conducted on 15th March in Udaipur, centred on the theme of 'Neonatal Imaging'. This event was organised by the Udaipur Chapter of Radiology.

The CME brought together paediatric radiology experts from across the country, including faculty from Delhi, Mumbai, Chandigarh, Jodhpur, Pune, Coimbatore and Madurai. The scientific programme featured targeted sessions on neonatal neuro, chest, abdominal and musculoskeletal imaging. These sessions emphasised contemporary imaging protocols, diagnostic strategies and case-based learning. 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QUIZ ANSWER: ZELLWEGER SYNDROME

Imaging findings:

•MRI Brain shows:

- Well-defined cystic lesions (arrows) in bilateral lateral ventricles along the caudothalamic groove
- Note no gliotic areas around the cysts
- Ventriculomegaly, especially occipital horns
- Mild hypomyelination in centrum semiovale
- Focal hemorrhage in sulci (arrow)

•Syndromic associations:

- Abdominal USG shows bilateral echogenic kidneys with multiple small renal cysts (arrows).
- Radiograph of bilateral knees revealed irregular calcifications of patellae (scimitar-like)

•Imaging diagnosis:

- Strong suspicion of Zellweger syndrome was raised

Final diagnosis (on whole exome test):

A homozygous pathogenic variant was detected in the PEX1 gene, associated with peroxisome biogenesis disorder 1a (Zellweger syndrome).

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QUIZ ANSWER: ZELLWEGER SYNDROME

Discussion

- Zellweger spectrum disorder, also known as cerebrohepatorenal syndrome, is a rare peroxisomal disorder in which peroxisome biogenesis is deficient. It includes Zellweger syndrome, neonatal adrenoleukodystrophy and infantile Refsum's disease.
- This autosomal recessive disorder is rapidly progressive and is characterized by severe developmental, neurological, hepatic, and renal abnormalities
- MRI brain findings include migrational derangement (not apparent in our case) including perisylvian polymicrogyria and fronto-parietal pachygyria. Germinolytic cysts in the caudothalamic groove, mild ventriculomegaly, a thin corpus callosum, and hypomyelination are also seen.
- Biochemical tests (elevated plasma very-long-chain fatty acids) and genetic testing aid in diagnosis. Due to the high mortality rate and lack of curative treatments, management is focused on supportive care. Genetic counseling and prenatal diagnosis are crucial.
